

# **THE INSTITUTES FOR BIBLICAL TRUTH 2010 APPLICATION FORM INSTRUCTIONS**

You are about to complete the Institute's for Biblical Truth 2010 Basics Level One application form. In the forthcoming 17 pages, you will find a set of thought provoking and heart challenging questions designed to help both you and the ministry staff of the Institute to learn about who you are, your needs, desires and background so that everyone who eventually is accepted to the Institute Basic Level Course may benefit to the highest level of what God desires for everyone possibly participating. Sometimes these applications may seem daunting, intimidating and a bit overwhelming but the questions in the following pages are absolutely necessary. Do not fear the questions or this process. This is simply part of the process Dr. Winslow uses in order to determine whether the Institute will be most helpful to you and whether she can genuinely help you to find your highest potential in God through the teachings and activities of the course. Many applicants often say that answering the application questions helps them to learn more about themselves, giving them greater insight into their own needs, goals and desires. Determine to answer the questions after prayer and honest reflection. Doing so will make the process much easier.

Once completing the application you are required to submit the \$25 application fee and either send the hard copy forms to Dr. Winslow or email the completed forms and send the application fee immediately. You must also send in 3 reference letters from 3 references for review. Your form will not be considered until the application fee and reference letters have been received.

Dr. Winslow will review your answers and then pray about whether you will be accepted or decline your application based on a variety of requirements, the most important of course the confirmation of the Holy Spirit. Acceptance is never guaranteed so do not make plans for flights and taking off of work until you have received a formal acceptance letter with travel plans and schedules.

Institute courses classes and acceptance procedures are constructed around a number of factors.

1. A balance of international participants with limited numbers from each national group to maintain cultural balance
2. Age groups are proportioned according to balance of generational grouping
3. Leadership potential as evidenced through application answers
4. Whether your personality type will balance within the group as a whole
5. Church, ministry, educational, vocational, cultural and family background, as well as mental and emotional health.
6. Reference letters
7. Financial responsibility
8. Honesty in answering the questions

9. Servanthood as indicated on the applicant's attitude and actual record of volunteerism in their community, local church and non-missionary organizations.

10. Ability to communicate clearly who the applicant is through the biography, current life conditions etc.

Again, do not let these things intimidate or hinder your completion of the following questions. Allow yourself to learn about yourself and what God is saying to you for the possibility of attending this course.

## **ACCEPTANCE POLICIES AGREEMENT**

I, \_\_\_\_\_ ( your name) hereby agree to adhere to and follow the Institute policies if I am accepted to attend the Institutes for Biblical so that I may enjoy the fullest value of my time in this course of Training. and be a blessing to the other students who will attend with me.

### **The following items must accompany the application if it is to be considered:**

1. A brief 3-5 page biographical sketch about yourself including some family background, Christian testimony, spiritual foundation, goals, dreams, gifts, calling and a vision for your work and ministry. Please give a detailed description of any spiritual experiences and church involvement you have had.
2. Photocopy of Ordination, license and/or certification
3. Three reference letters containing your signature releasing this information.
4. Recent head and shoulders photo- not photographed more then 6 months past. No sunglasses please. Please look your best!
5. Application fee: \$25.00 nonrefundable-Please be certain this is in your envelope to prevent a delay of processing your application.

## **Acceptance to the Institute Is Determined According to-**

1. No student will be accepted without completing the application form. Verbal applications aren't considered.
2. This isn't a self-help course for the emotionally disturbed. Applicants struggling with extreme burn out, and emotionally instability should not apply. Counseling is not available at the Institute, nor is this a counseling course.
3. It is PREFERRED that the applicant be involved in some form of present and future ministry leadership or business leadership prior to their application, and or some sort of volunteer organization. Individuals must be able to prove upon request that they have actually be involved in such and may also be asked to fulfill an interview requirement before their application will be considered. This is always a contributing factor in acceptance.
4. Applicants must be at least 18 years old to apply. No applicant under 18 will be considered. The intensity of the two week course can prove to be emotionally too much for persons under 18. Applicants under 21 may be interviewed if God leads for possible acceptance under unusual circumstances.
5. All applicants accepted must prove that they have a burden for the nations and an international emphasis. The Institutes for Biblical Truth are purposely cross-cultural and individuals struggling with this should not apply.
6. Acceptance to the Institute will be influenced by the clear communication of goals and vision of the applicant in their biography. Any applicant that attempts to influence any staff member or associate of the Institutes for Biblical Truth in the acceptance process will be automatically denied. This is strictly enforced.
7. Acceptance will be determined by the attitudes of humility, teachableness, servanthood, faithfulness to God and man, and spiritual mindedness as communicated through the applicant's biography and reference letters. Irresponsible handling of communications and management of the necessary requirements of the application nullifies any acceptance. This will be communicated to the applicant accordingly. We reserve the right to refuse attendance when irresponsibility, incompetence, poor communication or unforeseen spiritual conflicts are determined prior to the attendance of any accepted applicant.
8. No applicant will be accepted who is not fluent in spoken and written English.
9. No further acceptance will be granted to any applicant who has applied to any one type of Institute twice, and has been accepted twice and has repeatedly promised and failed to follow through with their acceptance requirements, financial commitment and promised attendance. We reserve the right to refuse any accepted applicant who demonstrates such irresponsible behavior.
10. Couples married for less than one year will not be accepted. It is highly preferred that both spouses apply and attend the same Institute. If one spouse is declined attendance, both will be denied. Problems with one of the spouses during attendance in any Institute of any type of problem, that could result in expulsion will result in the expulsion of the couple together.

Couples have very little time alone during the Institute. This is simply part of the sacrifice we have to make but it's only two weeks.

11. The atmosphere and housing set up for the Institute is hosted in several residential houses including the Winslow home, unless the classes prove to be too large. In such cases larger housing and classroom facilities will be arranged. Two-four students sleep in each bedroom. Bedrooms are available for a married couple if any attend. Bathrooms are shared 3-4 per bathroom. This community close environment may prove to be challenging for anyone who has never lived in this type of a set up for the two weeks time frame. Privacy is limited. Please consider this when applying as it will greatly affect everyone's reception and participation. All students will lodge together in this set up. No student may live off grounds during the Basics Level One Institute, during the course for which if they're accepted.

12. Dating or engaged couples should not apply to attend the same Institute together, and will not be accepted as a couple due to the distraction their developing emotions and relationship always creates. There are no exceptions in this policy for anyone.

13. Institutes are BUILT not just filled with accepted students. Factors that affect acceptance include the identifying of potential students whose Spiritual Gifting; Hunger for God more than hunger for information; Teachability; Personality type; Natural Talents; Emotional Maturity; Gender; Cultures; Life Experience; Age; Disciplines; Proof of Academic Responsibilities; Mental stability; Occupations and Calling all combined together indicate that the applicant can work with the rest of the persons accepted in order to provide a most profitable growing atmosphere for all involved. These factors are considered, and then the appointed staff diligently seek the Lord for His will as to whether that applicant will be able to fit into the Institute environment and an acceptance letter is given the applicant. Individuals are encouraged to submit their applications with the understanding that the purpose of the Institutes requires highly selective acceptance procedures. Applications are kept on file for 3 years.

14. **The Institutes are built on the principle of separation unto the Lord.** It is an atmosphere set apart from every day distractions and natural temptations. This means we emphasize setting ourselves to God entirely for the duration of the course. Individual usage of Videos, Television, Movies, Computer games and Internet activities are not allowed during the two weeks, so as to lay aside any visual distractions and totally focus on a time apart for God. Videos however may be part of the set and organized curriculum. The times for this separation requires that no student sets up outside meetings with friends, family, or business engagements so we can maintain our entire time with God. All accepted students are required to participate in this totally. This is very difficult for some, as we do not realize how dependent we have become on entertainment, outside influences, visual stimulus. There is NO acceptance to this policy and should be respected in all cases without exception. If you feel that you cannot abide by the principles guarding this holy time, please reconsider your application until that type of commitment can be made.

15. Students must be socially developed and demonstrate healthy social skills.

16. Students should be able to prove intellectual development capable of understanding the vocabulary and amount of material they will receive.

17. Due to the limited size of our facilities and home we are unable to accept couples with children, at this time. Parents, desiring to attend, must make separate arrangements for their children for the 2 weeks, as the schedule is totally scheduled and there is no extra time for family visitation or weekends off. Each day is full to the max. Please do not plan on bringing your children along and then HOPE to have time with them during the two weeks. It just isn't

available. This is a time separated totally to God, and we cannot accommodate extra time for family needs. In the future we do hope to conduct family Institutes, but until then we must adhere to this policy. Any parent who has been accepted as a student, and upon arrival, has ignored this policy and brings the children along, will not be allowed to attend. Until we have adequate space for children and to properly minister to the whole family, we must maintain this policy without exception.

18. As we do value the home and family, we know that this length of time could be difficult for parents to be away from their children. Children are often embittered by the absence the parents must take. Please take the appropriate steps to communicate to your children and ask them to bless and release you to attend if this appears to be a problem. If we determine that the acceptance of the student will damage the family, we will not accept the applicant until there is a peaceful release by the children affected.

19. The Winslows own 2 large lovable Golden Retrievers named Madison and Reagan. Students with allergies to dogs should take necessary precautions before attending the Institute to prevent allergic reactions to the dogs owned by the residents housing the students.

**Application forms must be fully completed with the appropriate application fee received and the form approved before a student may attend any Institute. No students will be allowed to attend without prior approval and acceptance from Dr. Tamara Winslow and the appointed staff personnel. Spaces for students will not be reserved for anyone without reception of a completed application, the three reference forms and acceptance letters and notification to students.**

20. All students and staff who participate in any Institute or Institute seminar are required to wear dress in the Institutes uniform of Business casual type of clothing. Hair and beards must be clean and neatly combed and trimmed. The dress code will be explained in more detail if the applicant is accepted.

**Expulsion of a student may and will result if one of the following situations is discovered-**

*...Lying on the application, or to a staff or teacher*

*...Repeated strife, murmuring or complaining, after having been confronted for such behaviors and having shown no signs of repentant change. Strife and murmuring will not be tolerated and will result in automatic expulsion. Divisiveness will not be tolerated.*

*...Immoral and inappropriate conduct or behavior as determined by the standards of the Bible ;illegal drug possession or usage, drinking of alcohol resulting in drunken behavior ,theft on the grounds of the Institute*

*...Attitudes that purposely and repeatedly hinder the instruction of the material or obstruct other students from being able to fully receive the things that God has for them.*

*.... Willful disobedience of Institute policy and procedure*
